Method(s) of Evaluation

- 2. **Quizzes (20%)**: Regular quizzes after each module assess understanding of key concepts and trade knowledge, allowing students to track their progress and review areas that require improvement.
- 3. **Project Assignments (20%)**: Practical assignments give students a chance to apply their knowledge to real-world plumbing scenarios, focusing on problem-solving skills and the ability to interpret trade standards.
- Practice Exams (30%): These timed, comprehensive exams simulate the Red Seal test environment, helping students practice exam strategies and familiarize themselves with the question format and difficulty level.



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5. **Final Exam (20%)**: The final exam assesses cumulative knowledge and skills acquired throughout the course, ensuring readiness for the Red Seal exam.

• Students must achieve a minimum grade of 70% to graduate from the program.
